Purpose

The aim of this policy is to protect all employees, customers and visitors from exposure to second-hand smoke and to comply with the Health Act 2006* / Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005* / Smoking (Northern Ireland) Order 2006* (*delete as appropriate).

Exposure to second hand smoke increases the risk of lung cancer, heart disease and other serious illnesses. Ventilation or separating smokers and non-smokers within the same airspace does not completely stop potentially dangerous exposure.

Policy

It is the policy of (NDST LTD) that all our workplaces are smoke free, and all employees have a right to work in a smoke free environment. The policy shall come into effect on (insert date) and will be reviewed on (insert date) by (insert name).

Smoking is prohibited in all enclosed and substantially enclosed premises in the workplace.

This includes company vehicles. This policy applies to all employees, consultants, contractors, customers or members and visitors.

Implementation

Appropriate 'no-smoking' signs will be clearly displayed at the entrances to and within the premises, and in all smoke free vehicles.

Employer Duties

- To display 'no smoking' signs as required by the legislation
- To ensure that employees, customers and visitors do not smoke in smoke free places and vehicles
- To investigate complaints regarding employees, customers and visitors smoking in areas which are designated as smoke free
- To inform, consult and train employees and visitors on this policy.

- To ensure that they or others do not interfere with no smoking signs
- To comply with the smoke free policy
- To ensure that customers and visitors do not smoke in smoke free places and vehicles
- To report incidents of smoking in smoke free areas and vehicles.

Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with this policy will be dealt with through NDST LTD's disciplinary procedures.

Those who do not comply with smoke free law may also be liable to a fixed penalty fine and possible criminal prosecution.
